You may qualify for tax relief if you meet ALL of the requirements under ONE of the following categories:

Required Supporting Documents

Elderly

- O Must be 65 years old (or older) as of December 31, 2025.
- Own and use the property as your primary residence.
- The combined 2024 income from ALL sources including spouse and co-owner must not exceed \$37,530.
- The spouse's and co-owner income is included whether or not they have an ownership interest in the property.
- All owners signatures must be present on documents. If an applicant for Tax Relief is unable to sign, they must make an X. Their mark must be witnessed by two persons and signed by the witnesses.

- Social Security & Medicare cards
- Documentation from Social Security indicating 2024 income (1099)
- O A copy of your 2024 income tax return (1040)
- Proof of age Valid driver's license or birth certificate
- O Mobile Home Title / Bill of Sale

Or

You must be totally and permanently disabled as rated by the Social Security Administration or other qualifying agency. Own and use the property as your primary residence.

- The combined 2024 income from ALL sources including spouse's and co-owner must not exceed \$37,530.
- Spouse's and co-owner income is included whether or not they have an ownership interest in the property.
- All owners signatures must be present on documents. If an applicant for Tax Relief is unable to sign, they must make an X. Their mark must be witnessed by two persons and signed by the witnesses.

- Documentation from Social Security indicating 2024 income & date disability began
- A copy of your 2024 income tax return (1040)
- Proof of age Valid driver's license or birth certificate
- O Mobile Home Title / Bill of Sale

Disabled



- O Own and use the property as your primary residence.
- No income is required.
- O You must meet one of the following disability requirements:
 - You must be rated totally and permanently disabled from a service-connected disability on or before 12/31/2025.
 - You must have a service-connected disability which resulted in paraplegia
 or permanent paralysis of both legs and lower body resulting from traumatic
 injury or disease to the spinal cord or brain; or loss, or loss of use, of two or
 more limbs, or legal blindness.
 - You must have a 100 percent total and permanent disability rating from being a prisoner of war.
